Woodcock Washburn Trial Team Assisted In The Creative Thinking Behind Microsoft's Supreme Court Victory

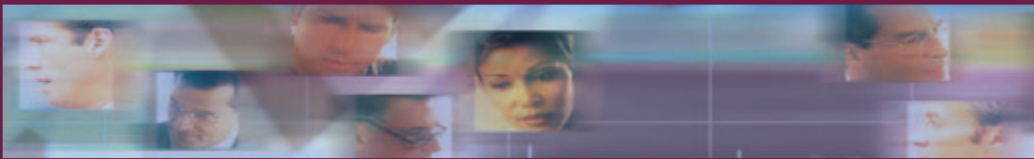

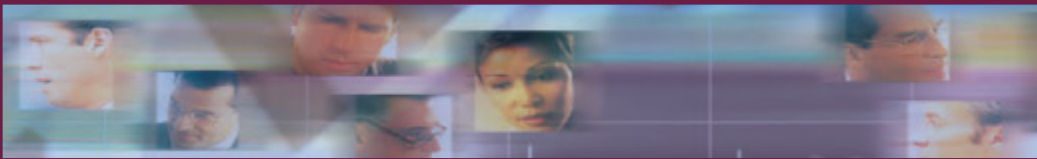
