## **TruePosition Wins \$20 Million in Additional Damages in Patent Infringement Case Against Andrew Corporation**

**Philadelphia** – U.S. District Court Judge Sue Robinson in the District of Delaware awarded TruePosition, Inc. approximately \$20 million in additional damages, plus certain attorneys’ fees and court costs, in continued patent infringement litigation against Andrew Corporation, a division of CommScope, Inc.

In September of 2007, a Delaware District Court jury determined that Andrew willfully infringed a patent held by TruePosition relating to control channel Uplink Time Difference of Arrival (U-TDOA) location technology. Specifically, the jury found willful infringement with respect to sales of Andrew’s Geometrix<sup>®</sup> wireless location system to the Saudi Telephone Company (STC). Andrew, however, continued to ship infringing products to STC after trial “under a veil of secrecy” (to borrow the court’s words). Accordingly, the Court awarded TruePosition an additional \$10.1 million in compensatory damages, \$9.6 million punitive damages, pre-judgment and post-judgment interest, as well as costs and attorneys’ fees related to the pursuit of these damages. This award is in addition to a previous award of \$23.25 million in compensatory and punitive damages relating to infringing Geometrix<sup>®</sup> sales made to the same customer. The Court also issued a final permanent injunction order prohibiting Andrew Corporation from making, using, selling or offering to sell the infringing Geometrix<sup>®</sup> products.

“We are very pleased with the outcome in this case and Woodcock Washburn’s consistently effective advocacy,” said Frederic Beckley, Executive Vice President and General Counsel of TruePosition. “This decision secures the fact that TruePosition has vital intellectual property surrounding U-TDOA and further establishes TruePosition as a global leader in mission-critical wireless location solutions.”

TruePosition was represented by a Woodcock Washburn team led by Paul Milcetic, who argued the post-trial motions on TruePosition’s behalf, and that also included Gary Levin, Lynn Morreale, Amanda Kessel, Dan Goettle and Jeremy Dukmen.

The case is *TruePosition, Inc. v. Andrew Corporation* (Civ. Act. No. 05-747-SLR).

TruePosition, of Berwyn, Pa., is a leading provider of wireless location technologies and solutions and a subsidiary of Liberty Media Corporation. TruePosition filed suit in 2005 charging Andrew with infringing its patent which helps determine the position of mobile devices. The patent deals with the location of wireless phones using the wireless network control channel, known as the “144” or “control channel” patent, and is particularly important for safety and security applications.

In February 2004, Woodcock Washburn obtained a \$35 settlement for TruePosition as well as warrants entitling TruePosition to purchase one million shares of Andrew's common stock at a price of \$17.70 per share for a period of four years along with licenses to certain Andrew intellectual property. *TruePosition v. Allen Telecom Inc.* (D. Del. 2004).
