We also looked for wins that could effect significant social change or civil rights gains. Firms needed to devote at least 50% of their litigation resources to plaintiffs' work. We don't pretend this is anything but our subjective take on the major players in the plaintiffs' bar. We looked for firms that struck us as representing the bar's best qualities and that demonstrated unusual flair and creativity.
